<b>1. Biodata page of passport or travel document</b> with validity of not less than 6 months. (JPG, JPEG limit Size is 3 MB)
2. Photograph taken within the last 6 months with a light background. (JPG, JPEG limit Size is 3 MB)
3. Travel booking confirmation (ticket itinerary) (PDF limit Size is 3 MB) * Applicant should only apply for a visa up to 3 months before the intended arrival date
4. Proof of Accommodation in Thailand, please select one of the options: (PDF limit Size is 3 MB)
Staying in a hotel/apartment: a reservation confirmation for half period of your stay in Thailand with the name, address, <b>and</b> contact details of the hotel/apartment.
Staying with a non-Thai citizen: an invitation letter, passport, visa/residence/ work permit in Thailand, and the house register (Ta-bien-baan)/buying contract/rental agreement.
<ul> <li><u>Staying with a Thai national:</u> an invitation letter <u>with</u> Thai ID or passport <u>and</u> the house register (Ta-bien-baan).</li> </ul>
Staying with a non-Thai citizen: an invitation letter with their passport, visa/residence/work permit in Thailand, and the house register (Ta-bien-baan)/buying contract/rental agreement.
<ul> <li><u>Staying in the applicant's residence in Thailand:</u> proof of residence ownership, e.g., a land title deed or buying contract.</li> </ul>
5. Document indicating current residence, e.g., valid Swiss permit card (PDF limit Size is 3 MB)
6. Visa Fee of 40 CHF (single entry) / 180 CHF (multiple entry)
